## VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

### Stewards

The majority of our volunteers will be required to work 2 x 8hr shifts over the course of the festival weekend. Shifts will run between 6pm on Thursday to 10am on Monday morning. Shifts run over 24hrs, so night work may be required, but we'll do our best to let you know well in advance.

Stewards may be required to:

- Support security staff by checking wristbands at site entrances/exits
- Direct traffic at the entrance and car park
- Patrol campsite and arena areas
- Provide information to festival-goers
- Man entrances to various stages
- Assist Head Stewards with other tasks as and when they arise

### Head Stewards

We also need a small number of Head Stewards, who will each oversee a team of 10 stewards. You will be the first point of call at the festival for your team members, dealing with any problems and ensuring your team turn up for their shifts. You will also liaise with the Volunteer Managers if any problems arise. Training will be provided for Head Stewards.

This is a great opportunity for anyone interested in gaining experience for your CV of volunteer and events co-ordination. Head Stewards will be required to work 2 x 8hr shifts over the weekend and carry out other duties outlined in the 'Steward' section above.

### Early Bird Volunteers

We're looking for a small number of volunteers to arrive early on site to assist with set up. Early-bird volunteers will arrive on site no later than 10am on Wednesday morning and work 2 x 8-10hr shifts from Wednesday through to Thursday evening. It'll be hard work and not for the faint hearted, but once you've finished your shifts you'll be free to stay and enjoy the rest of the festival weekend!

Early-bird volunteers may be required to:

- Assist with the set up or dressing of stages, tents and other site areas
- Direct traffic, deliveries and other volunteers as they arrive on site
- Put up signage
- Assist with setting up art installations
- Assist senior team members with other tasks as and when they arise

**Clean-up volunteers**

At Moor Fest we like to leave the countryside as we found it, but inevitably after a weekend of revelry we need a little help with the clean up! We will need a small team of volunteers to remain onsite until Monday evening. You will be required to work a 10hr shift on the Monday. **Remember, if you choose to go home early and not complete your shift your deposit will not be returned.**

**NB. The number of Early Bird and Clean-up needed is limited and will be selected on a first-come first-served basis. Please state which role you would prefer in your Application Form.**
